## RESULTS

Germany leads with well-structured programs and strong university-business collaborations, while Greece and Cyprus are expanding EE mainly through project-based and extracurricular learning in non-business faculties. Turkey emphasizes practical experience but lacks formal integration outside business disciplines. Future priorities for EE include embedding it into diverse curricula, fostering value co-creation to address modern economic and social goals, and enhancing partnerships with businesses for real-world problem-solving. Educator training in entrepreneurial methods is also essential, promoting a holistic, interdisciplinary approach to EE that can drive economic and societal impact.



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
